They form part of the Wisdom Teachings, which have their roots in the mystery schools of ancient Egypt and classical Greece. The order and structure of the Major Arcana, the twenty-two most powerful cards in a Tarot deck, are based on the Hebrew system of numbers and the alphabetical sequence of its twenty-two letters. In fact, the name Tarot (pronounced "ta-roh") is closely related to the Hebrew word Torah. This word means "The Law" and is applied to the Five Books of Moses found in the Old Testament. The language of the ancient Hebrews was written without vowels. Thus both "Torah" and "Tarot" could be written simply by using the two Hebrew letters representing "TR."--

Manuscripts from the era reveal that there was a specific way of laying out the cards and there was a divinatory meaning associated with each card. The tarot has four suits, but this can vary depending on the region. Jean-Baptiste Alliette, popularly known as Etteilla, was the first to create a tarot deck especially for the purposes of divination. This 78-card deck has two distinct parts.
